Tark Kolch – Who requested to have four officers here? Hutchison said it was for public safety. Mt Hope Bridge project was questioned if state approved materials were used and if guidelines were followed, if it was put out for bid, why wasn't liquid fuels money wasn't used. **Board Response -** the materials used were acceptable and bought according to guidelines, and didn't need State inspection, its under 23 feet, and yes it was put out for bid, using liquid fuels money for other things.

Renee Bonselli – How can we rally support from the water company coming through her property? Not to eminent domain. Her fourth time. **Long** responded a resolution could be passed opposing the matter legally. And questioned if the State Senator had been contacted. The answer was yes.
