

ORDINANCE OF WAYNE TOWNSHIP NO. 4 of 2014

An Ordinance by Wayne Township, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania, Amending Ordinance No. 1 of 2006 and Requiring the Owners or Occupiers of Real Estate Within the Township to Prevent the Growth of Grass or Weeds Beyond the Height of Eight Inches Within One Hundred Feet of Any Residence or Commercial Building.

WHEREAS, the Wayne Township Board of Supervisors enacted Ordinance No. 1 of 2006, regulating the height of grass within a certain distance of residential or commercial buildings;

WHEREAS, the Wayne Township Board of Supervisors believes it is necessary and in the best interests of the Township that Ordinance No. 1 of 2006 be amended with respect to the height and distance requirements set forth therein;


NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Wayne Township, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

Section 1. Restriction of Vegetation.

Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1 of 2006 is amended to provide that from and after the enactment of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any owner or occupier of real estate situate in the Township to permit the height of grass or weeds growing on said real estate within one hundred (100) feet of any residence or commercial building to exceed eight (8) inches.
