Wayne Township Board Supervisors Meeting was held April 2, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. at the Municipal Building, 1418 Wampum Road, Ellwood City, PA 16117. Chairman, Dennis Hall opened with the Pledge of allegiance lead by Wayne Township.

In attendance were Chairman, Dennis Hall; Supervisors, Robert Abraham and Charles Hutchison, Secretary/Treasurer, Shari D. Baney, and Township Solicitor, Ryan C Long.

Robert Abraham made a motion to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. Hutchison 2<sup>nd</sup> that motion. All in favor, motion carried.

## PUBLIC INPUT:

**Tootie Welsh 1)** Tootie wanted to know the status of the newsletter and plans for the Wayne Township 160<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration. Dennis Hall stated the newsletter should be ready around April 20th. He also said he spoke to Dom Vaccari of Ellwood Boro about the usage of the main shelters for this event with the possibility of the event occurring mid September. We would be looking for volunteers. Hall stated we collected \$2,600.00 and this would cover the cost of the print and postage for mailing.

**2)** It was reported to Tootie that there was a bid put in for the adjoining property so her question was, did the Supervisors put in another bid for the property? The answer was no. They would have to present such an item before the Board and go from there, but they did not! The original bid was refused but there were no other bids

**Bill Hepler** – Questioned the township if it could put money into other things and equipment why does the Township garage looks so shabby and deplorable. Could we not put new windows and improve the looks to the Township garage. Discussion on it was made with the promise something would be done.

## OLD BUSINESS:

Hall asked what was the status on the Crabapple Lane Ordinance. Ryan Long, Solicitor said it was there to vote on. It was already advertised, etc. He will file and get with the Dept of Transportation to complete the process and see about the Liquid Fuel Refund monies. Hall made a motion to accept the Crabapple Ordinance, Robert Abraham 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All in favor.

Green Acre -- NEW: \$44,840.00 USED: \$22,750.00

Keystone Guide Rails –NEW: \$43,925.00 USED: \$24,150.

Hall made a motion to reject all bids due to costs; Abraham 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All in favor

Discussion on using existing guide rails and purchased 800 feet of used and complete the areas needed railing. Bob Abraham discussed the liabilities when putting guide rails in and that is why we put it out for bid. Ryan Long suggested, “a case law review be done before the job begins. Hall made a motion to move forward with the purchase of 800 feet of guide rail and use our used guide rails and do the work ourselves which would include areas of the township line near Ray McQuiston’s home on Dutch Ridge Road; Van Horn section, close to Sullivan’s. Uncertain but may need to rethink about the Van Horn area. Chuck Hutchison made a motion to do work ourselves; Dennis Hall 2<sup>nd</sup> it. All in Favor.

Motion was made by Robert Abraham to accept Barry’s bid; Hutchison 2<sup>nd</sup>. That. All in favor.

**Street Sweeper Sale** – Dennis Hall made a motion to sell the street sweeper for \$2,500 to Ferndale Boro, per the Municibid Auction Sale. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Chuck Hutchison. Motion carried.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Hutchison made a motion to purchase a pickup broom off of State Contract in the amount of \$3701.60. This could attach to the skid steer for street sweeping. Question arose about dust prevention? There is a mount that could curtail the dust and keep the operator healthy. Abraham 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Motion carried.

Motion to purchase a tilt attachment for the skid steer was made by Chuck Hutchison. Mr. Hutchison said there is a possibility we could purchase one “after market price”.(State Contract) for the price of \$1,482.45  
Abraham 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All in favor.

Hall made a motion to **pay the bills**. Hutchison 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All in favor.

Abraham made a motion to **adjourn the meeting**, ; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Hutchison. All in favor.
