The Wayne Township Supervisors, 1418 Wampum Road, Ellwood City, PA 16117 held its monthly Supervisor Board Meeting on Thursday, November 3, 2011 @ 7:00 p.m.

Meeting opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance" lead by Chairman/Supervisor, Dennis Hall; prayer by Supervisor, Bruce Badger. Also in attendance were Supervisor, Chuck Hutchison; Township Solicitor, Ryan Long; and Assistant Secretary Brandy Fullmer.

Motion was made by Badger to "**Approve the Minutes**" from October 6th; 2nd by Hutchison. All in favor.

Old Business: Approval of the sale of the 1995 Kodiak in the amount of \$8910.99. Motion was made by Chuck Hutchison; 2nd by Bruce Badger. All in favor.

Approval of the County Aide Grant money for Sunset. Motion was made by Chuck Hutchison; 2nd by Dennis Hall. All in favor.

New Business:

Flood Plain has to be done and turned in by Jan 12th 2012. Ryan Long needs to get in contact with Waltz Consulting. Then will advertise the flood plain. Then we will be able to send out the information as needed. Motion to except by Dennis Hall; 2nd by Bruce Badger. All in favor.

Motion to approve the use of the remaining funds from the sunset grant in the amount of \$2100.00 on another road in the township to be named later. Motion made by Bruce Badger; 2nd Chuck Hutchison. All in favor.

Approval of **Financial Report** from Water, Light, Bldg/Equip, Liquid Fuels and General Accounts was made by Hall, 2nd by Hutchison. All in favor.

Badger made a motion to "**Pay the Bills**", 2nd by Hutchison. All in favor.

Solicitor's Report –Ryan asked about the Ordinance for Marcella Shale. Wants to know about the setting of standards of road bonds and what they limit. This will need to be advertised, discussed and voted on. Ryan will need to get in touch with Ken Herman about the 2011 audit and see if we need a Resolution on this. Motion on all of this was made by Dennis Hall; and 2nd by Chuck Hutchison. All in favor.

- Comments were made about Donnie Ray Frelin's yard. He will be sited. Supervisors stated that the police were send out . All cars are legal. Frelin has started to work on cleaning the yard up. As long as he is working on it the township will work with him.

Old Business

- Clean up day was completed on Oct. 8
- 200 tons anti-skid material was received
- 100 tons salt was received
- Some of the anti-skid and salt has been mixed for use
- Catch basin and storm sewage pipe have been placed on Peach and Actna Dr.
- Trees were removed from Line Ave, Jockey Moore Rd, Mt. Hope and Hollow Rd.
- Park Gate was laid out and PA call was made
- Spreader was placed on the 2001/550
- Preventative maintenance was done on all trucks
- The catch basins were cleaned in the township

Future Plans

- Continue mowing road berms, weather permitting
- General Winter Maintenance of the trucks
- Complete Park Gate project
- Road signs will be picked up from Ohio

Phone Log for October

- A resident wanted to fill out a complaint form for an on-going drainage problem. She was asked to wait for next year's paving project
- McCronich reported that he will be working for Halloween, although he is not listed on the schedule. Supervisors will also be out, their time will be donated
- A resident would like to know when the paving is to be done, so he can rearrange his schedule for painting his house. The work has been completed.
- The roof on the township building has been repaired by Duralast Roofing.
- The driver from Arrow would like to deliver the load of salt. It was delivered
- Chas. Hudson Law Associates would like to have the police report for the 8/13/11 accident on Old Pittsburgh Rd. This will be turned over to the state police.
- Numerous calls were received about the fall clean-up. 86 loads were collected, an increase of 30 from the last township clean-up
- Central Contracting called to authorize the secretary as point of contact for CDBG-R
- A resident brought photos and list of problems with the recycle bins. The police are working on the problem

- A resident of Aetna Dr. wants to know when the street will be fixed. Columbia Gas is handling the problem
- The water committee used the building for Lower Chewton residents
- A request to move a dumpster on 16th street was received. It is not on township property.
- A call about Americol Mining and the bend in the Rd in Chewton was received. It is a state road.
- A question about emptying the recycle bins was received. It is picked up on Monday and Friday. There will also try to schedule Wednesday.
- The truck is repaired by Valley Spring. A helper spring was installed on the 2001/550
- John Johnson called to let us know we are approved to use the remaining funds on another road project
- Penn Dot reported that two school bus signs were installed on Eidemiller Lane
