The Wayne Township Supervisors, 1418 Wampum Road, Ellwood City, PA 16117 held its regular monthly Supervisor Board Meeting on Thursday, May 3, 2012 @ 7:00 p.m.

Meeting opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance" lead by Chairman/Supervisor, Chuck Hutchison; prayer by Supervisor, Bruce Badger. Also in attendance were Supervisor, Bill Hepler; Township Solicitor, Ryan Long; and Secretary/Treasurer, Shari D. Baney.

Motion to "Approve Minutes" made by Hutchison; 2nd by Hepler. All in favor.

Old business - - Opening of Paving Bid, RFQ #1-2012 for Streets: Squaw Run & Mt. Hope

Motion by Hutchison to accept Quote #1 with Addendum by Protech Asphalt Paving in the amount of **\$88,712.91**; 2nd by Hepler. All in favor.

A meeting with McConnell Insurance Agency to discuss **Health Coverage**. Insurance premiums have increased to the point township officials were looking into other means of health insurance coverage: PSATS, 1-person coverage in lieu of "group coverage". **August 1st**

Mrs. McCandless questioned the status of the Frelin property complaint. She felt the township was not serious about her complaint. Hutchison stated papers were served to the Frelins and it is in the hands of Jerry Cartwright. All takes time and the township must follow proper procedures. Hutchison said Chief Betz is on top of it and if the Chief would deviate from the way the Ordinance is worded, the McCandless complaint would be null and void. He suggested McCandless put a dumpster in. Hutchison said if the Frelins put tires on the vehicle it shows "he is working on it..." Betz checked the motor home registration, hasn't been registered for 11 years. Frelin said he would get rid of it. Repeating, Hutchison said it all takes time. Long suggested you contact the Magistrate's office and find out when the hearing is. Magistrate normally provides "some time" with instructions, and if they do not follow it then they would be in violation of the ordinance. The Magistrate could set a fine; suspend the fine; etc. A visiting Magistrate is right now.

Hutchison also said Betz, in addition to going to the magistrate's office, has gone up to the Frelin's to measure all the vehicles because the Ordinance states that if the vehicle is 150' from a road or a lived-in structure, it is okay to keep it. It was asked why not change the Ordinance if it was made in the 40's but Hutchison said we are looking to zoning within the next year.

Zoning representative Tootie Welsh gave the status of Zoning. She said they were "fine tuning it" & then it goes to Public Hearing; was expecting late summer. She said Danielle from L. C. should be there. Long said he would contact her. Hutchison: if the Zoning is not approved then they would look into re-writing the Ordinance.

New Business, a motion made by Hutchison to approve the Resolution for the Burt Lauten Municipal Authority Sewer Line Agreement (Northwestern Drive/Lundy's Lane). Responsibility is with the Sewer Authority. 2nd by Hepler. All in favor.

Motion to join the **Chamber of Commerce** in the amount of \$100. 00 for insurance purposes was made by Hutchison, 2nd by Hepler. All in favor.

Motion to approve the Donation of \$1,200. each for **AED defibrillators** units was made by Hutchison; 2nd by Hepler. All in favor. Accepting the award for the Chewton Vol Fire Dept was Erin Kelly; and Scott Bathurst and daughter Bethany for the Wayne Township Vol. Fire Departments.

Motion to Approve the **Financial Report** and **Pay the Bills** made by Hutchison; 2nd by Hepler. All in favor.

Solicitor's Report: **Tony Ditko Road** ---looking into it.

Public Input: Ann Graham wanted to know what the township was going to do with her road. The condition of this road has been going on for over 10 years. Badger said it would cost about \$10 - \$15,000 to fix the road and the township does not have the money. Badger also said to raise that road, she would not be able to get into that driveway. Mrs. Graham has contacted an attorney.

Sally Byler complimented Lawrence County, Jerry Zona, for doing the clean-up on "Earth Day". Hutchison said they also cleaned the "working trail".

Tootie Welsh said the people doing the seismograph test/studies were in the township to do testing for property owners. Badger said he was meeting with them in June, July and August. 3 pieces of major land amounting to about 400 acres awaiting to sign (Wampum Road – Jockey Moore).

Lenore Bazzichi wanted to thank the township for the police patrol in her Park Gate area. Hutchison said we now have a drug task force officer to call the office.

Burt Lauten & wife introduced themselves to the township and thanked the township for the sewer line approval and for the cooperation of the township officials & administration.

Hutchison said all the Supervisors plus Brandy will be taking the CDL Probable Cause & CDL Records Management Workshop on May 30, 2012 at Hutchison Park.

- He said on May 15th there would be paving on Aetna Drive for the gas-line road interruption.

Erin Kelly was concerned about the River Road area, that cars roll-over in that one particular area. She asked about a 'speed-trap' being set up. She asked if the road could be bermed. Hutchison said it was fixed 2 years ago; they would look at it again.

Hutchison made a motion to "**Close the Meeting**". Hepler 2nd it. All in favor.
