The Wayne Township Supervisors, 1418 Wampum Road, Ellwood City, PA 16117 held its regular monthly Supervisor Board Meeting on Thursday, June 7, 2012 @ 7:00 p.m.

Meeting opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance" and prayer lead by Vice-Chairman/Supervisor, Bruce Badger; . Also in attendance were Supervisor, Bill Hepler; Township Solicitor, Ryan Long; and Secretary/Treasurer, Shari D. Baney. Absent, Charles Hutchison.

Motion to "**Approve Minutes**" made by Hepler; 2nd by Badger. All in favor.

Old Business --- None

New Business— Brandy Fullmer resignation accepted by Badger; 2nd by Hepler. All in favor.

Resolution #6 of 2012 – CDL driver's exemption functions; can work overtime. In the case of an emergency, workers can work more hours than the stipulated time. Motion to accept by Badger; 2nd by Hepler. All in favor.

Approval of **Financial Report and Bills to be Paid** – motion by Hepler; 2nd by Badger All in favor.

Solicitor's Report – Re: Tony Ditko Road ---The township can, by ordinance, vacate Tony Ditko Road. Long said a written petition could be submitted to the supervisors; landowners would be notified; then the township could draft an ordinance, advertise, enact, it, ordain it.

Badger Report – included: 36 phone calls; future work plans; old work. **(See attached).**

Public Input:

Tootie Welsh commented on the fire hydrants need to be free of weeds—that was in the original contract. There are three on Wampum Road.

Resident **Dell McQuiston** of 941 Squaw Run Road has water problem because of years of tar and chip. Road is higher & it goes clear down to 967 Squaw Run. The high point in the road is causing water run-off into his drive. The location is two houses back from Larry Cole's home towards the fire-hall, same side of the road.

Delores McCandless back again with an update on the Frelin's vehicles. Badger said the Frelins said they were putting license & tires on the car. Hutchison told Badger, that the Frelins have another 30 days on the motor home. Hutchison requested a "priority list" from the McCandless. Badger said Hutchison & the police have been out to the Frelin's home. Badger said some things are enforceable and some are not. Chief Betz reported on the Frelins and said they are working on it. He said vehicles are registered; its lawful. The red car has plates & inspection and plates for the Lincoln. This is in the hands of the Magistrate and the process can take time per Long. Long said the McCandless could file a civil suit, that is an option. High grass in that area was a topic of concern from the McCandless.

Caesar Crane – Re: the culvert next to Crane’s home-- A ditch, widened out and stone put in, was done by the township. Crane was told the State did the work. Crane said water is coming down the side of the road and washing his driveway out. Township employee, Roger Stramba, said the State is supposed to cut it out and slope it towards the creekbed.

Hepler said the August meeting will be held on August 7th and will be advertised.

Resident, Patty Hutchison employed by Grove City Hospital, conducted the CPR/AED classes free of charge. Wayne Township wanted to thank her and the hospital for donating their time and the AED cards to the township.

Badger made a motion to adjourn; Hepler 2nd the motion. All in favor.
