The Wayne Township Supervisors, 1418 Wampum Road, Ellwood City, PA 16117 held its regular monthly Supervisor Board Meeting on Thursday, June 6, 2013 @ 7:00 p.m.

Meeting opened with the “Pledge of Allegiance” lead by Chairman/Supervisor, Chuck Hutchison; prayer by Supervisor, Bruce Badger. Also in attendance were Supervisor, Bill Hepler; Township Solicitor, Ryan Long; and Secretary/Treasurer, Shari D. Baney.

Motion to “**Approve Minutes**” made by Hutchison; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Hepler. All in favor.

## **New Business:**

- ❖ Squaw Run Bridge #2 red-flagged by Taylor Engineering. Shut-down Friday, May 31, 2013, until further notice. Community & entities notified.  
Residents questioned bridge weight-limit, road speed, and annual bridge inspections.  
It was noted that the Squaw Run Road Bridge #2 will be paid for by the township; 2<sup>nd</sup> one, Squaw Run Road #1 will be figured in the Liquid Fuels funds.
- ❖ No Animal Control available. Upon retirement, resident Dell McQuiston offered to do it.
- ❖ The abandoned Wiley home in lower Chewton, 110 Mason, currently owned by bank, has high grass. It was suggested the township mow the grass and charge them; put a lien against the property.

## **Old Business:**

- ❖ **Ordinance 1 of 2013 – Road Weight Limit Ordinance.** Motion to approve ordinance made by Hutchison; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Hepler. All in favor.
- ❖ **Babst/Calland** – requested copy of the adopted Road Weight Limit Ordinance. Authorized by Long. No action. This is a law firm that maintains a database.
- ❖ Lawrence County Planning—Adhoc Committee release Final Zoning Draft to Ryan Long for review and suggestions. Badger read a letter by L.C. Planning, Amy McKinney stating they rescinded (no longer functional) the resolution they sent to the township. Long said to forward a copy of the new proposed Zoning Plan to him as well as to Morrie Waltz’s office. He will then incorporate Morrie’s and Amy’s comments. It will then go on to the Planning for review and then onto the Township Supervisors. It was stated the L.C. Planning is not abandoning us but are willing to work with us. They dropped their fee.

It was mentioned the State Police have been parked at the Gardner’s driveway because of speeding. Bridge Street is bad –along side of the road.

Gibbon’s office called about the speed limit and a sign, next to the tree, needed grass mowed.
