The Wayne Township Supervisors, 1418 Wampum Road, Ellwood City, PA 16117 held its Monthly Supervisor Board Meeting on Thursday, April 2, 2015 at 7:00 p.m.

Melinda Cappello opened the meeting with the “**Pledge of Allegiance**” and a “**Moment of Silence**”. Officers in attendance were Supervisors: Chuck Hutchison, Chairman; Bill Hepler, Rick Weingartner; Township Solicitor, Ryan C. Long; and Secretary/Treasurer, Shari D. Baney.

Motion to “**Approve the Minutes**” was made by Hepler, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Weingartner. All in favor.

**Guest Speaker:** Long introduced his friend and former colleague, Judge Candidate, **John DeCaro**. DeCaro thanked the township for the opportunity to speak to the township. He is running for Judge in the judicial campaign. DeCaro shared his law experience that also included family domestic issues. He said he is the only candidate with that level of practice.

**Public Input:** Tootie Welsh resubmitted her roof repair bill, previously submitted at the February meeting. She thought there was a break in the system. The township was inactive towards that bill.

She asked why Morrie Waltz received a “retainer fee” that no one else charges a retainer. She also wanted to know what his fee was for the month. She also wanted to know what the grand total was to do the Ordinance (Zoning).

## **New Business:**

**County Grant Application** for Aetna Drive in the amount of \$18,000 - \$25,000. Motion to approve was made by Hutchison; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Weingartner. All in favor.

**Animal Control Officer** –An application from Wendi Weigand was submitted to the township for the Animal Control position. Wendi was also recently hired by Ellwood City for their animal control. She is a WT resident and is available 24/7. She can be reached at 724-674-8297.

Motion by Hutchison to call her in and interview her; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Weingartner. All in favor.

**Paving Project** – A motion was made by Hutchison to widen Linden Avenue, per the submitted Protech Asphalt Maintenance quote in the amount of \$6,800.00. Area is not to exceed 760 sq. ft. Hepler second the motion. All in favor.

Hutchison said there will be no new road paving this year. The roads will be resealed instead. Hutchison said using Liquid Fuel Funds; he would like to order approx. 1,200’ of pipe. Motion for consideration in doing Mt. Hope, Cole Road, and Joffre Street was made by Hutchison; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Weingartner. All in favor.

Amend the **Land Development Ordinance** to allow temporary job trailers onsite. Long wanted to know if there was any particular language he needed. Hutchison made a motion to have Long advertise and check with Morrie Waltz on any changes.

Hepler, who 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion, wanted to know who is going to monitor this? All in favor.

Motion to “**Approve the Financial Report and Pay the Bills**” from General Account made by Hutchison; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Weingartner. Motion to approve all the other ledgers: Building, Light, Water, Liquid Fuel made by Hutchison; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Hepler. All in favor.
