The Wayne Township Supervisors, 1418 Wampum Road, Ellwood City, PA 16117 held its Monthly Supervisor Board Meeting on Thursday, July 2, 2015 at 7:00 p.m.

Meeting opened with the “**Pledge of Allegiance**” and a “**Moment of Silence**” by Assistant, Melinda Cappello . Officers in attendance were Supervisors: Chuck Hutchison, Bill Hepler, Rick Weingartner; Township Solicitor, Ryan C. Long; and Secretary/Treasurer, Shari D. Baney.

Motion to “**Approve the Minutes**” for June, 2015 was made by Hutchison; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Weingartner. All in favor.

## **Public Input:**

**Edward Wharrey** – 356 Reserve Square addressed the Board about the possibility of closing an alleyway/paper road. Atty Long said he should retain an attorney for action on a “Quiet Title” so property can be transferred into his name. Long said you purchase insurance so you are insured with your property. John DeLuca has a building on their property.

**Rita Woloszyn** – wanted to know the rules and regulations for quads/dirt bikes/ATV’s. She said she filled out a “**Complaint Form**” about the quadders/dirt bikes riding on streets to get to the Chewton ballfield. She said they travel on Reserve Square, with no regard for stop signs or intersections. She said they go up and down Eliza Street most evenings up to 1:00 a.m. but you could also catch them in the mornings, as well as noontime.

Officer McCronich was in the office when Woloszyn submitted her complaint and she mentioned that to him. Her words, “He blew her off”. She wanted it on record that she did not like being dismissed like that.

She said with Chief Betz living down there, she could not understand why the police were not involved.

**Tootie Welsh** – spoke regarding ‘an ongoing roof complaint/bill’. She wanted to know the line of responsibility: 1) Contractor; 2) Jane Waltz; 3) Supervisor. Long said there was no legal liability based on when that application was made. Welsh said Jane Waltz ‘inspects’; work should have been ‘recap to her chimney’.

Welsh wanted to know who should be administering these grants?

## **New Business –**

**Complaint Form** – In order for township to act on the many complaints coming in, complaints must be in written form. Copy of “**Complaint Form**” attached.

- Long said he talked to Morrie Waltz about non-traffic citations. Hutchison said the township is going to start filing them. We are getting many complaints about 8” grass.
- Also, Hutchison would like a form letter addressing property owners to maintain the stormwater. Long said he has created a form letter. He is going to forward over to the township office.
- **Ques:** Hutchison asked Long if the township could force people to put new culverts in their driveways? Long said you cannot force them but you can tell them the road crew is going to come through and dig-it-out; ditch it all out.
- **Ques:** Hutchison, can we put liens on their property? Long said if we have an ordinance that requires them to maintain stormwater. He said, with North Sewickley, property owners were informed they were to maintain their driveways.
