The Wayne Township Supervisors 1418 Wampum Road, Ellwood City, PA 16117 held its monthly Supervisor Board Meeting, Thursday, May 3, 2017 at 7:00 p.m.

Meeting opened with the "**Pledge of Allegiance**" and a "**Moment of Silence**" lead by Chairman, Bill Hepler. Officers in attendance were Supervisors: Rich Weingartner; Township Solicitor, Ryan Long, and Secretary/Treasurer, Shari D. Baney.

Motion was made by Hepler to **Approve the April, 2018 Minutes**. 2nd by Weingartner. All in favor.

PUBLIC INPUT: Tony Woloszyn wanted to know what the status of our Police Chief? Hepler said he spoke to Bill Betz and he was doing better & back to work. Woloszyn asked about our township supervisor, was he still on the payroll? He was told he received his quarterly check. Long said there is nothing in the township code that requires he attend so many meetings.

Executive Session -- Board recessed and returned. Helper explained the meeting was for personnel and litigation issues.

NEW BUSINESS:

Motion by Hepler for the **2018 Wayne Township Paving and Tar & Chip**, as follows: 3,000 ft Paving Camp Allegheny; 2,852 feet, Single Coat – Tar/Chip: Kate Houk; 3,000 feet Double Coat – Tar/Chip: Line Ave; 3,864 feet Single Coat – Tar/Chip: Line Ave; 1,225 feet Single Coat – Tar/Chip: Jockey Moore Road. 2nd by Weingartner. Motion Carried.

Equipment Sales: Roger Baney explained they sold the paver, the ditch witch, ink cartridges, etc., for approximately \$5,000.00 . Baney explained the leaf vac was quoted at 3,300; trailer, \$3,000. The township wanted \$4,000.00 for the trailer. If you want to put those items put back on the Municibid, public and government can purchase these items. There is vinyl fencing that was purchased when we had recycle bins that can be put on the municibid process. Motion by Weingartner to put these three items back on municibid with a minimum bid. Township can put a reserve on the items.

June's original Wayne Township Board of Supervisor's meeting date will be cancelled and rescheduled for **Tuesday, June 12, 2018 at 7:00 p.m.** This will be advertised.

Old Business:

Road Grader Backplate was tabled last month and brought up at this meeting. Weingartner made a motion to approve the purchase of a new "backplate" for the roadcrew,, approximately \$5,000.00. 2nd by Hepler. Motion carried.

Andy Mravintz -- wants to build a garage on his property, secretary told him zoning requires a principle structure on the property before he can build a garage. Long said there is a difference in "permitted use"; versus a "conditional use". An appeal was held and granted for the gentleman in ParkGate. Long will review the Zoning and thinks there is something he can do to work it out.

Mravintz also wanted to know his rights about a Christmas tree overhanging onto his property. If this is his own property, Long said he does have the right to cut/trim (however this is not a legal advisement from Atty. Long). Mravintz said the trees are between the survey corner and on the road, which is state.

SOLICITORS REPORT: Nothing.

Supervisor's Report –Wall cleaning proposal was submitted by the same outfit that cleaned the floors, in the amount of \$300.00. A motion to clean the walls made by Weingartner; Hepler 2nd. Motion carried.

Camera – old cameras were removed and new ones installed, the new tax collector requested first options on buying it. Discussion was made and Hepler made a motion to donate the camera to the tax collector; 2nd by Weingartner, Motion carried.

Roadworker – Township needs to advertise for a new roadworker per submitted advertisement. Advertisement will run for 5 days. Motion by Hepler; Weingartner 2nd the motion

Financial Report – Motion by Hepler to approve the General, Building Equipment, Water, Light, & Liquid Fuels Ledgers; 2nd by Weingartner. Motion carried. **Motion to Pay the Bills** – by Hepler; 2nd by Weingartner. Motion carried.
