Motion was made by Weingartner to approve the April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019 Meeting Minutes. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Hepler. All in favor.

## **PUBLIC INPUT:**

Burnstown resident, Donna Jacobs, spoke at length concerning an issue with the Tire shop next door to her home. Jacobs stated there are thousands of tires that are open and creating a health hazard for her and the neighborhood, to the point she needs to wear netting just to be out in her yard due to the mosquitos. Jacobs stated the value of her home is reduced by 30% due to the tire shop according to a local realtor. Attorney Long recommended appointing an alternative Code Enforcement Officer so the issue can be dealt with promptly. No action taken.

Earla Marshall from Kitchen Cabinets' gave a brief explanation of assistance needed for Clean Water Ways. Marshall read a prepared statement.

Lisa Czerpak questioned why we pay PA One for calls.

Tootie Welsh questioned why the bill for Jeff Richardson was so high, explained it is a quarterly check.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

Brief discussion on the Dollar General store to be built at the old Bowling Alley. No permits requested at this time.

Jeff Richardson recommended the township enact a Property Maintenance Code. Attorney Long stated we should seriously consider as it would supersede and consolidate many old ordinances. Long also recommended having the Planning Committee review and make recommendations. Tabled for more information.

Hiring of a part time Office Clerk, Hepler stated they received one application from Laurie Hay from Ellwood Road.
