The Wayne Township Supervisors 1418 Wampum Road, Ellwood City, PA 16117 held its monthly Supervisor Board Meeting, Thursday February 6, 2020 at 10:00 7:00 P.M.

Meeting opened with the "**Pledge of Allegiance**" and a "**Moment of Silence**" lead by Chairman/Supervisor, Bill Hepler.

Motion was made by Hepler 2nd Weingartner to approve the January 6, 2020 Meeting Minutes. All in favor.

PUBLIC INPUT: Wes Cunningham brought up the issue of lack of ambulance coverage in the township. Cunningham said it takes 35-40 minutes for an ambulance to get to any scene in Wayne Township and the situation is getting worse. Cunningham said a partial solution would be getting the Fire Department to be 1st Responders. Cunningham also stated the Ellwood and Wampum Firemen are certified. Cunningham suggested the Township solicit assistance from the County Commissioners. Hepler questioned why can't the surrounding townships consolidate service to help each other. Cunningham also said their A.E.D. is getting outdated and questioned about a getting a new unit. Hepler said he would rather have the company inspect all the units and replace what is necessary. Secretary will contact the company and set an inspection date if possible.

NEW BUSINESS: Road Bond Agreement – Graziani Construction applied for Lundy Lane. Motion to approve Weingartner, 2nd Hepler.

Road Bond Agreement – JM Logging from Dutch Ridge Road to Wurtemberg Road.

Fleet Card Program: Hepler said he is checking into adopting the program. Details are each Police Officer will receive a credit card and be required to complete gallons purchased and mileage at time of purchase. More details to follow.

Co-Stars – Salt Bid is due by March 15, 2020. Roadmaster Stramba will determine the need based on the quantity on hand. Motion to approve Weingartner, 2nd Hepler.

A Proclamation honoring the First Missionary Baptist Church of Chewton for their 100-year Anniversary was signed by the Supervisors.

Ordinance – 2nd Amendment concerning the right to bear arms was discussed. Chief Magnifico said the police and the District Attorney of Lawrence County have no issues. Hepler motioned, Weingartner 2nd to have Attorney Long prepare the Ordinance.

Cat Clinic – Discussion on the need for the Township having a schedule of clinics monthly as it interferes with the Cleaning Service. Weingartner will discuss with Wendy of the Cat Clinic.

Lawn Tractor Purchase – brief discussion on prices and models for a lawn tractor needed for the Township to mow the grass. Supervisors are getting more prices.
