Motion was made by Hepler to approve the Monday, January 4, 2021 Reorganizational Meeting Minutes. 2nd by Weingartner. All in favor.

Supervisor's Report –

- 1) Update on the Squaw Run Road Bridge/Payment. Bid amount: \$168,687.00. Amendment to contract for extra guardrails and gravel, approx. \$6,500.00

- 2) DCED Grant Money – Awarded to the township for the Squaw Run Road Bridge project is \$100,000.00 with \$5,000.00 going to the project audit. Ryan Long said resident Ed Leymarie praised the job the township did on the bridge.
- 3) March Insurance Renewal: McConnell said the Platinum Level Plans were eliminated; new plan is the Gold Level Plan. Rates went down but the deductible went up to \$1,000.00 per employees. This will be reimburseable by the township, per Long. Motion to approve by Hepler; 2nd by Weingartner. Also, agency noted eligible employees be enrolled in Part B Medicare.
- 4) Status on the Huffman/Seybert vs. Owens septic system on Dutch Ridge Road. Hepler said Morrie Waltz addressed this, that it is not leaking at the Seybert property; will go and inspect Owen's septic when weather breaks.
