BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING
MAY 5, 2022

The regular monthly meeting of the Wayne Township Board of Supervisors was held on Thursday, May 5, 2022, at 7:00 P.M. at the Wayne Township building, 1418 Wampum Road, Ellwood City, PA. Supervisors in attendance were William Hepler, Marc Cunningham, and Richard Weingartner. Solicitor, Ryan Long and Secretary/Treasurer, Samantha Laszlo attended via teleconference.

VISITORS: Visitors in attendance were Lori Tillia-Meeker and guest, Bob Cunningham, Wes Cunningham, and Tootie Welsh.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, William Hepler beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance followed by a Moment of Silence.

Weingartner made a motion to approve the minutes from March 3, 2022. Hepler seconded the motion. Motion carried.

PUBLIC INPUT:

Lori Tillia Meeker expressed concern with the new traffic pattern created on S.R. 288 and Oswald Street. She is requesting that Wayne Township reach out to PennDOT to see if something can be done. Hepler let her know that we will request a Road Study be performed.

Wes Cunningham asked if the Township would be interested in splitting the cost of a generator for the Wayne Township Fire Department. The generator would be large enough to power a warming and cooling station at the department in case of an emergency. Hepler recommended that Cunningham get a price before making any decision.

NEW BUSINESS:

A motion was made by Weingartner to approve Wampum's ACT 537 Plan. Cunningham seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Hepler made a motion to appoint Kristy Carofino as Auditor to fill the vacant position. Motion was seconded by Weingartner. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Hepler to approve Resolution 4 of 2022. This resolution is a revision to the demolition permit process. Weingartner seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Weingartner made a motion to advertise the Townships 2022 Paving Project. Motion was seconded by Cunningham. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Hepler made a motion to advertise for two vacancies on the Zoning Appeal Board. Weingartner seconded the motion. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF FINANCIAL REPORT: A motion was made by Hepler to approve the financial report. Motion seconded by Weingartner. Motion carried.


BILLS TO BE APPROVED: Weingartner made a motion to approve to pay the bills. Motion seconded by Hepler. Motion carried.
