BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING
November 3, 2022

The regular monthly meeting of the Wayne Township Board of Supervisors was held on Thursday, November 3, 2022, at 7:00 P.M. at the Wayne Township Building, 1418 Wampum Road, Ellwood City, PA. Supervisors in attendance were William Hepler, Marc Cunningham, and Richard Weingartner. Solicitor, Ryan Long attended via teleconference. Secretary/Treasurer, Samantha Laszlo was also in attendance.

VISITORS: Visitors in attendance were Tootie Welsh, Jared McElwain, and Michael Lubenski.

William Hepler called the meeting to order, beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance and then a Moment of Silence.

Weingartner made a motion to approve the minutes from October 6, 2022. Cunningham seconded the motion. Motion carried.

PUBLIC INPUT:

Mr. Lubenski asked about the status of the condemned house in Burnstown. Supervisors Weingartner and Hepler approved Solicitor Long to follow up with the property owner to see what her intentions are.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ordinance 1 of 2022- Tax Waiver Request:

The Ordinance allows the Tax Collector to make available a "Tax Waiver Request" prepared by DCED to waive additional charges for real estate taxes to a taxpayer failing to receive notice of real estate property taxes, provided the taxpayer makes a claim for the waiver within twelve months of a qualifying event. A motion was made by Cunningham to approve Ordinance 1 of 2022. Motion seconded by Weingartner. Motion carried.

Hepler made a motion to advertise a Resolution approving the appointment of a CPA for the 2023 fiscal year. Weingartner seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Cunningham made a motion to approve and advertise the proposed 2023 budget. Hepler seconded the motion. Motion carried. The budget will be available for public inspection and presented for adoption at the December 1, 2022 meeting.

Weingartner made a motion to approve Resolution 8 of 2022 for the Lawrence County Transportation Funding Grant for the River Road Improvement project. Hepler seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Cunningham made a motion to approve Resolution 9 of 2022 for the Lawrence County Transportation Funding Grant for the 2023 Paving Project. Motion seconded by Weingartner. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Lawrence County Transportation Grant Allocation for Road Salt in the amount of \$13,088.51.

APPROVAL OF FINANCIAL REPORT: A motion was made by Weingartner to approve the financial report. Motion seconded by Cunningham. Motion carried.

BILLS TO BE APPROVED: Weingartner made a motion to approve the payment of the bills. Motion seconded by Cunningham. Motion carried.
