REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING  
**May 4, 2023**

The regular monthly meeting of the Wayne Township Board of Supervisors was held on Thursday, May 4, 2023, at 6:00 P.M. at the Wayne Township Building, 1418 Wampum Road, Ellwood City, PA. Supervisors in attendance were Marc Cunningham and Rick Weingartner. Solicitor Ryan Long and Supervisor William Hepler were absent. Secretary/Treasurer Samantha Laszlo was also in attendance.

Supervisor Weingartner called the meeting to order, beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance and then a Moment of Silence.

Weingartner motioned to approve the purchase of ammunition for the Police Department. Cunningham seconded the motion. Motion carried.
