REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING
June 1, 2023

The regular monthly meeting of the Wayne Township Board of Supervisors was held on Thursday, June 1, 2023, at 6:00 P.M. at the Wayne Township Building, 1418 Wampum Road, Ellwood City, PA. Supervisors in attendance were William Hepler, Marc Cunningham, and Rick Weingartner. Solicitor Ryan Long and Secretary/Treasurer Samantha Laszlo were also in attendance.

BILLS TO BE APPROVED: Weingartner motioned to approve the bills' payment. Hepler seconded the motion. Motion carried.


SOLICITORS REPORT: Nothing to report.
